

This is an embed code that generates a 3D presentation when placed on a web page. Adjustable parameters (the ones that you can change) are shown in color below; actual values are replaced with text in CAPITAL letters:

The parameters are explained below:

param name="src" value="%SRC%" and src="%SRC%"
%URL% is the full path to a .dcr file, where your 3D album is stored (do not change this parameter).

param name="sw1" value="%NOSTART%" and sw1="%NOSTART%"
%NOSTART% can be "true" or "false". If the value is "true", then the album starts playing automatically. Otherwise, it requires a mouse click to start.

param name="bgColor" value="%COLOR%" and bgcolor="%COLOR%"
%COLOR% is a background color, an example value is #9999CC

param name="sw3" value="%WIDTH%", param name="sw4" value="%HEIGHT%", width="%WIDTH%" and height="%HEIGHT%"
%WIDTH% and %HEIGHT% are the values of your album width and height respectively. You can set any values for them, but it is advisable to set both values between 160 and 1024 pixels.

param name="swURL" value="%URL%", param name="sw5" value="%FILEWITHURLS%", param name="sw6" value="%TEXTWITHURLS%", swURL="%URL%", sw5="%FILEWITHURLS%" and sw6="%TEXTWITHURLS%"

The code can contain ONLY ONE of swURL, sw5 or sw6 parameters that define the way of getting image URLs:

%URL% is the URL of a folder that contains *swplaylistxml.txt* file (it must have exactly this name). The *swplaylistxml.txt* file contains image URLs list with attributes. For example, you can define param name="swURL" value="http://pho.to/my_album/gallery" (be sure to duplicate the same path here: swURL="http://pho.to/my_album/gallery"). You can find the specification for the *swplaylistxml.txt* file in the archive.

%FILEWITHURLS% is the URL of any text file (html, txt, xml), that contains image URLs. This text file can be, for example, a page source code and can contain other text besides image URLs.

%TEXTWITHURLS% is any text containing image URLs. For example, param name="sw6" value="http://.../image1.jpg http://.../image2.jpg" (don't forget to duplicate the same text here: sw6="http://.../image1.jpg http://.../image2.jpg").

Note!

- 1) Parameters are duplicated to make the embed code compatible with most internet browsers.
- 2) In the archive you can find a sample embed code and specification for the *swplaylistxml.txt* file.
